



WHAT DO TEENS NEED FROM ADULTS?

Teens need adults who will....

- 1. Listen.
- 2. Model strength, openness, respect, trust, and cooperation.
- 3. Provide good information to assist them in life's decisions.
- 4. Respect their intelligence at all times.
- 5. Value teens' fears and problems as genuine.

WHAT DO TEENS NEED FROM ADULTS?

Teens need adults who will....

- 1. Not try to force change on anyone.
- 2. Prevent rudeness, judging (especially judgments about appearance), lecturing, attitude of disrespect, or the attitude that one is "incorrect" or blameworthy for what she/he believes at the present time.
- 3. Recognize that small steps and activities are important and need to be encouraged.
- 4. Welcome and celebrate making mistakes and be willing to risk and learn.
- 5. Listen, listen, praise, praise, respect, respect.

Parent's, never forget that you were once a teenager. You were once stupid and crazy.

"Parents should not forget their childhood years, how much they yearned for sympathy and love, and how unhappy they felt when censured and fretfully chided. They should be young again in their feelings, and bring their minds down to understand the wants of their children." Ellen White, Counsels for the Church, page 191
